Any and all cables, wires and power cords
Any and all circuitry (circuit boards)
Batteries (non-automobile)
Audio/Video Equipment: CD players/Radios/Stereos/DVD Players/VCR's/Video Game Consoles
Cellular Phones/Pagers/Telephones/Telephone Equipment/Answering Machines
Computers/Laptops (including all associated peripherals and hardware)
Keyboards/Mice
Laboratory, Test and Measurement Equipment
Microwave Ovens
Modems/Routers/Hubs
Monitors
Server, Network and Storage Equipment
Printers/Fax Machines/Scanners/Copiers/Duplicators/Typewriters
Telecommunications Equipment
Televisions
UPS's (Uninterrupted Power Supply)

Acceptable equipment can be described generally as any piece of equipment that has a power cord and is not a home appliance.
